Hi All,

With the development of the new Amaruq-Whale Tail Pit operation, two fuel tanks will be added to the fuel farm near the Agnico dock. In support of this expansion, Agnico Eagle would like to let Baker Lake community members know this will require crushed rock to be hauled from Quarry 2 at kilometre 13 on the All Weather Access Road (AWAR), to the fuel farm. This hauling will be done with large 50-60 ton rock haul trucks during the night.

For the health and safety of community members and workers, **some areas of the AWAR** (marked in red) will be closed from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. starting April 30, 2019, for a maximum of six (6) weeks.

If emergency access is required during the night (8 p.m. to 8 a.m.) a contact person will be stationed at the intersection marked with an 'X' on the map.
