Did you know that every person working at a mine site must be trained in the use of firefighting equipment such as the use of fire extinguishers? It is a requirement of the Nunavut Mine Health and Safety Act and Regulations.

Under the Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Regulations all employers in Nunavut also have a duty to train employees on the correct procedures to follow in the event of a fire.
