## Wildlife Protocol on the Meadowbank Road

Twice a week a Wildlife survey is done on the AWAR ( Environment department and one local person)

### Speed Limits

- Vehicular traffic speeds on the access road must not exceed **50 km/hr.**
- Where small to moderate aggregations of caribous (i.e., 1-50 animals) are observed within 100 m of the road, travel speeds should be reduced to **30 km/hr.**
- Where large aggregations of caribous (i.e., 50 or more) are observed within 100 m of the road, at the discretion of the road supervisor, vehicle movements **may be suspended** until animals have moved away from the road.

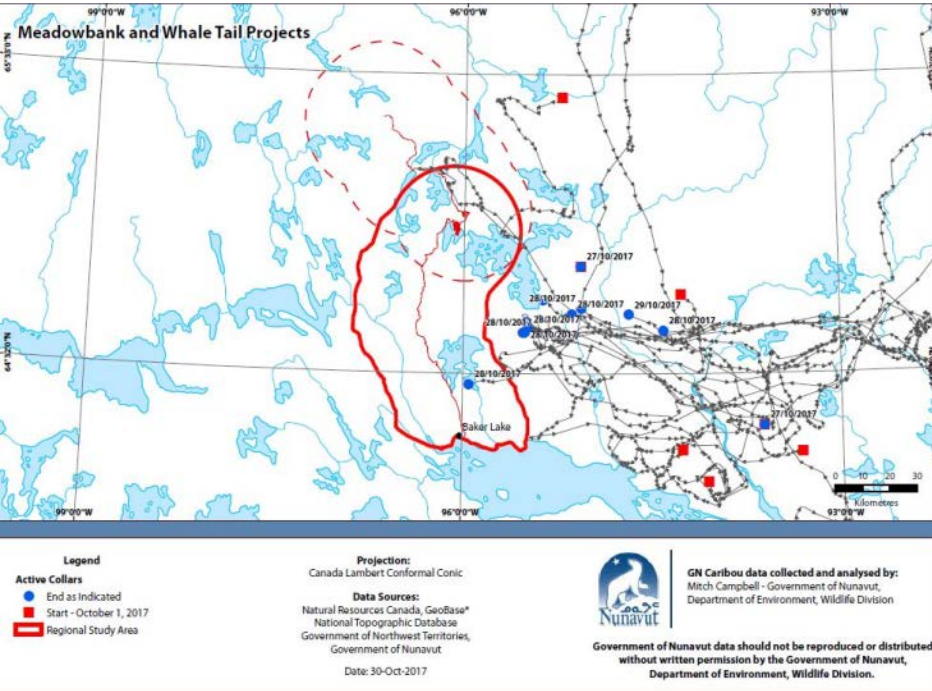
## Animal Right-of-Way

- Caribous and all wildlife will be given **right-of-way** on the road. Vehicles must stop until caribous are off the road.
- Locations of **large aggregations of animals must be reported** to the road supervisor who will inform all potentially affected employees and the environment department.

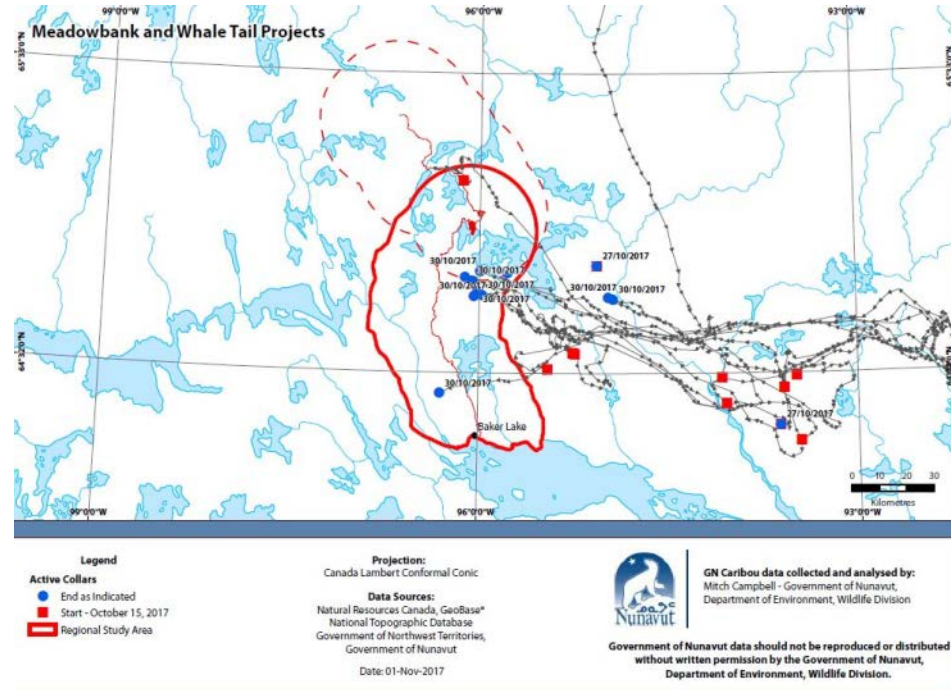

➤ **October 26<sup>th</sup>** : We received a report that it had a lot of caribous on AWAR

After inspection by Environment team, it was decided to close the road for all night until further inspection

➤ **October 27<sup>th</sup>** : AWAR inspection combined with INAC and KIA was done.

After these inspection it was decided to maintain the road closed but daily ride escorted North and South

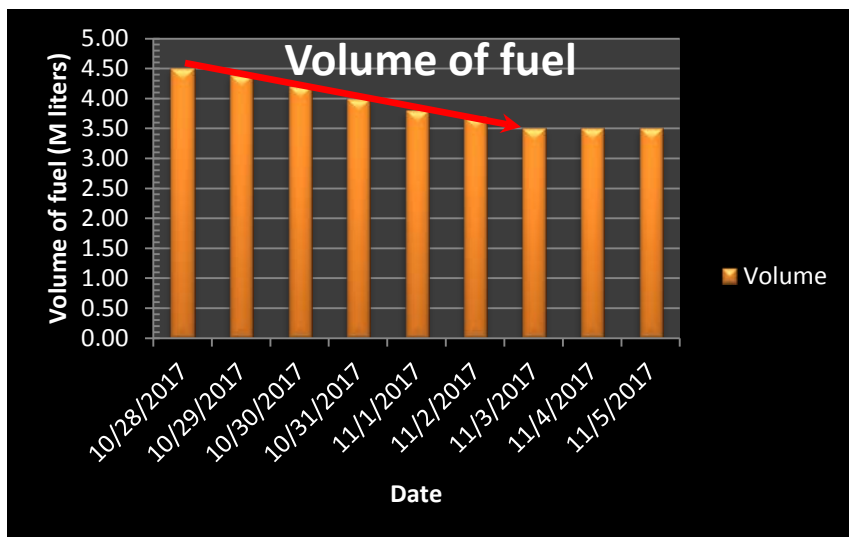
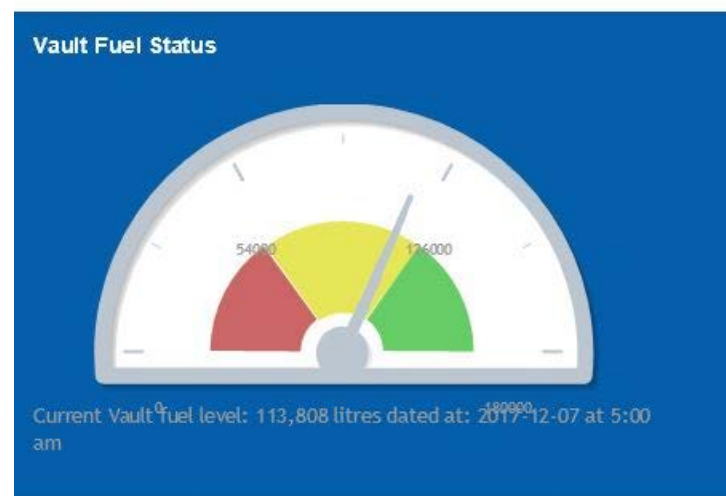
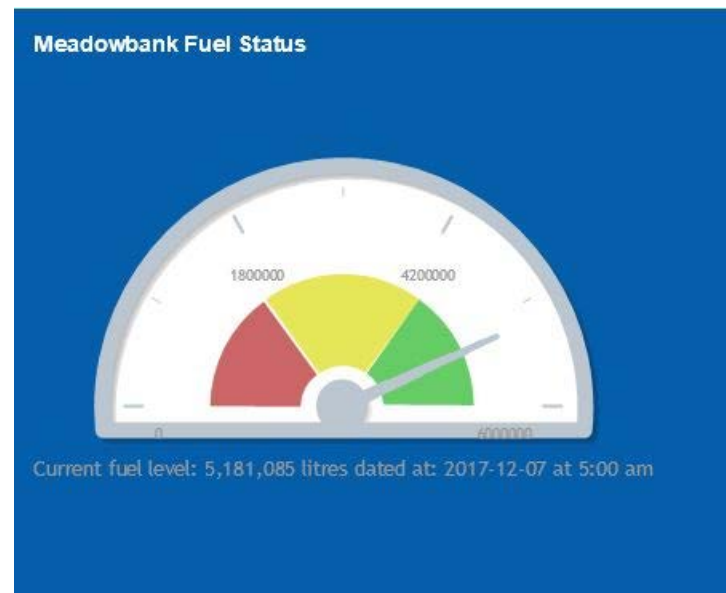
- ➔ The AWAR road was maintained close from October 26<sup>th</sup> until November 3<sup>rd</sup>

- ➔ Daily inspections were done on each road (AWAR and AMQ)

 November 3<sup>rd</sup> : 3.5 M liters





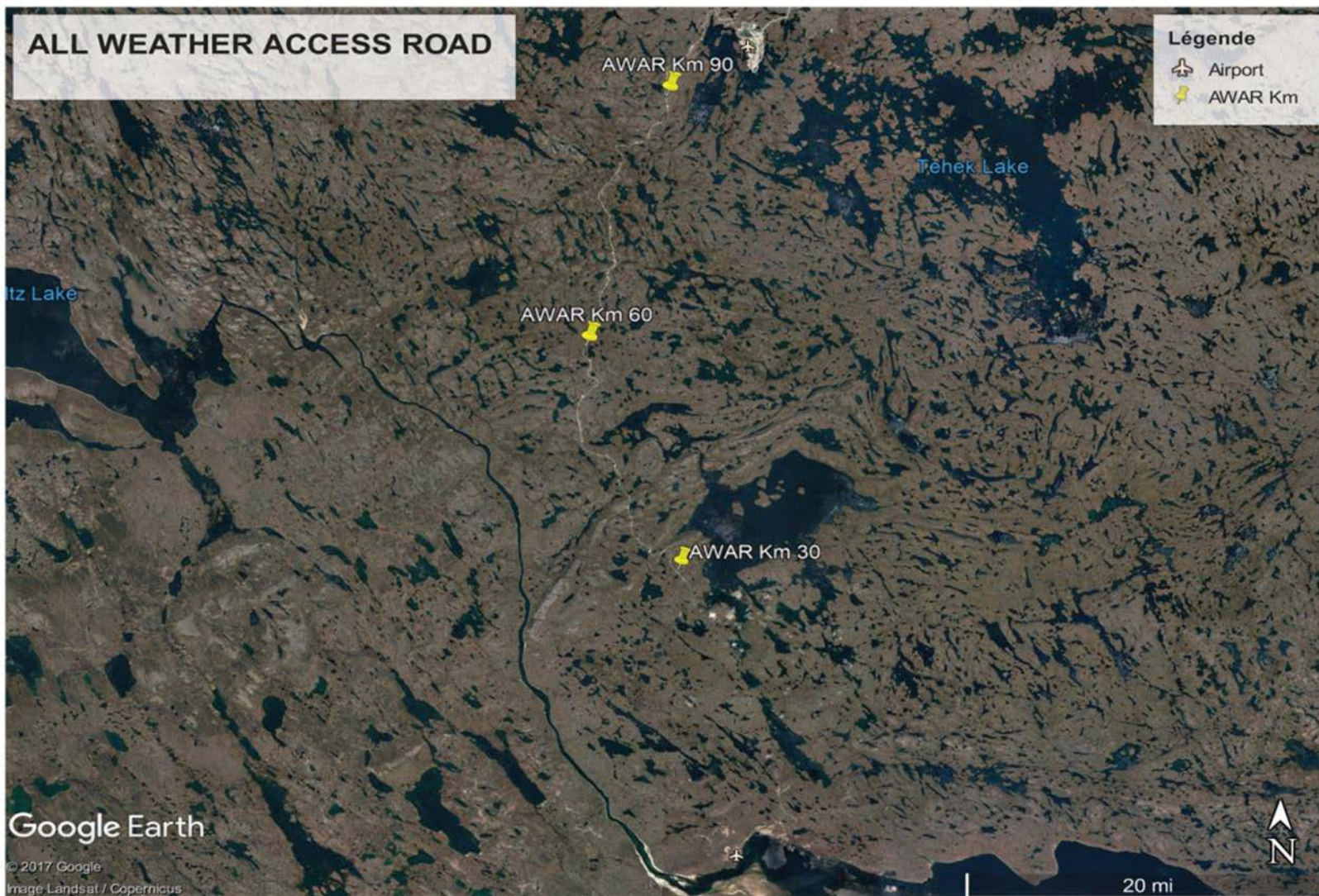
# CARIBOU MIGRATION FALL 2017

- Other convoy have been allowed, but always after discussion with each parts. Convoy were escorted with HTO member (AWAR), KIA, and Environment department.



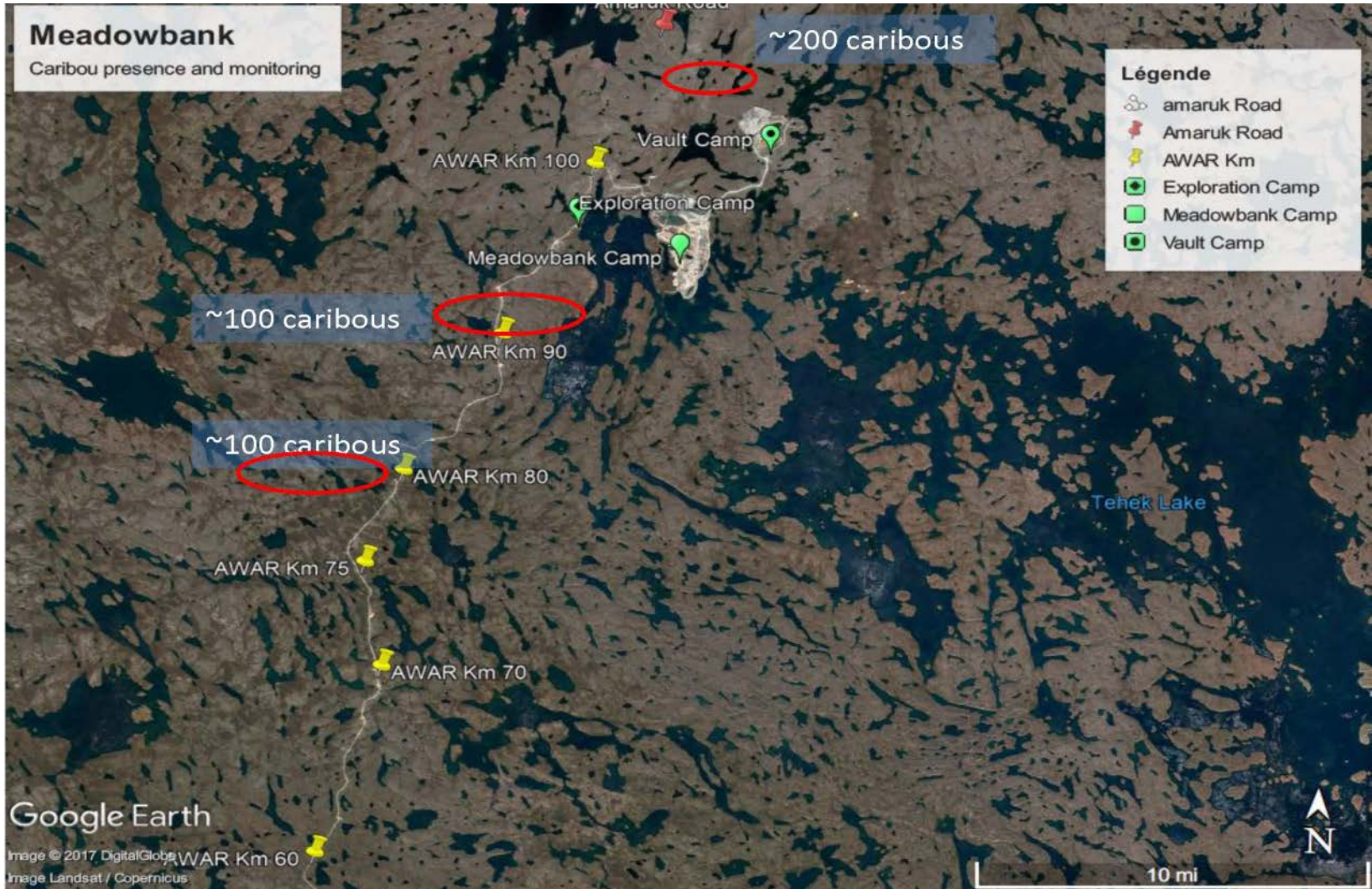

## ➔ ALL WEATHER ACCESS ROAD (Global)



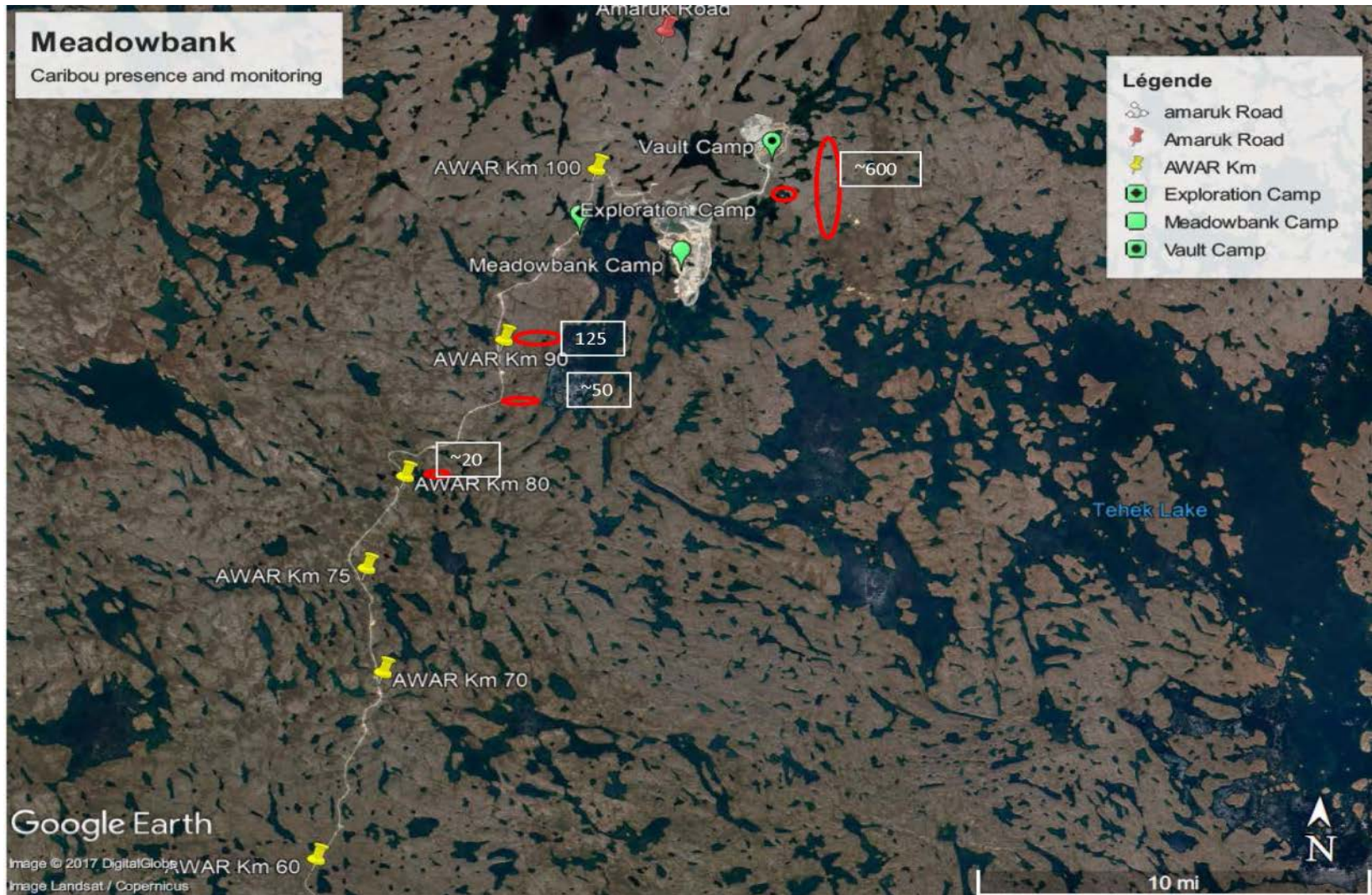
